SLOW RELEASE NITROGEN

Greens and Tees: 5 oz. per 1000 sq. ft. every two weeks. Split applications to every week on light and sandy soils. Increase rates to 8-10 oz. per 1000 sq. ft. on sites with identified plant stress or reduced vigor.

Fairways: 1 gallon per acre per month or as needed.

Sports Fields: 1.5 gallons per acre once per month or as needed.

Ornamentals: 4 oz per in 2 gallons, diluted 50:1, drenched into the soil around the root ball.

Available in a 2 x 2.5-gallon box and 55-gallon drums.
